The equipment will be returned to the school on a date to be requested. Borrowers who do not return the computer and related materials when requested will be charged the cost of the equipment to their student account. If the laptop equipment is lost, stolen or damaged while in the borrower's possession, borrower is responsible for the cost of the replacement or repair thereof.

Any included software may be used only in accordance with the applicable license and it is the borrower's responsibility to be familiar with and to comply with the provisions of such license.
