

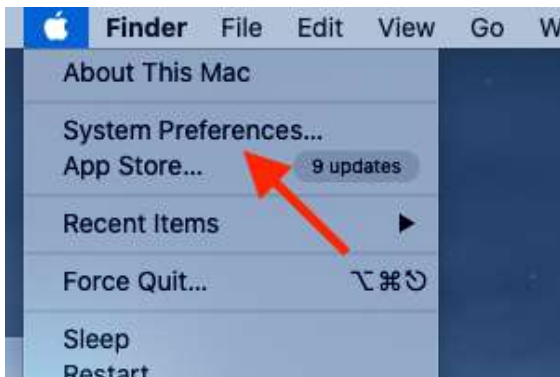
# Forgetting a Wireless Network

## Apple macOS

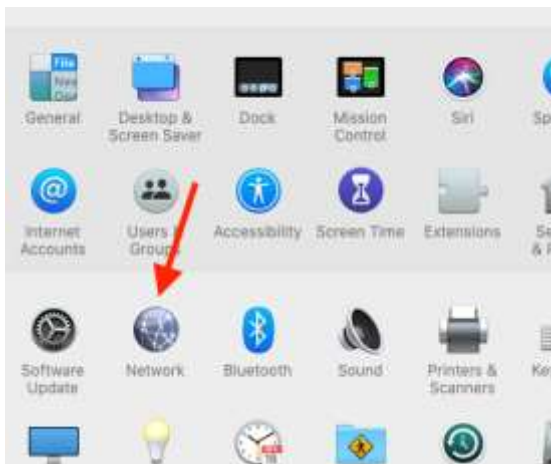
1. Click on the Apple menu in the menu bar



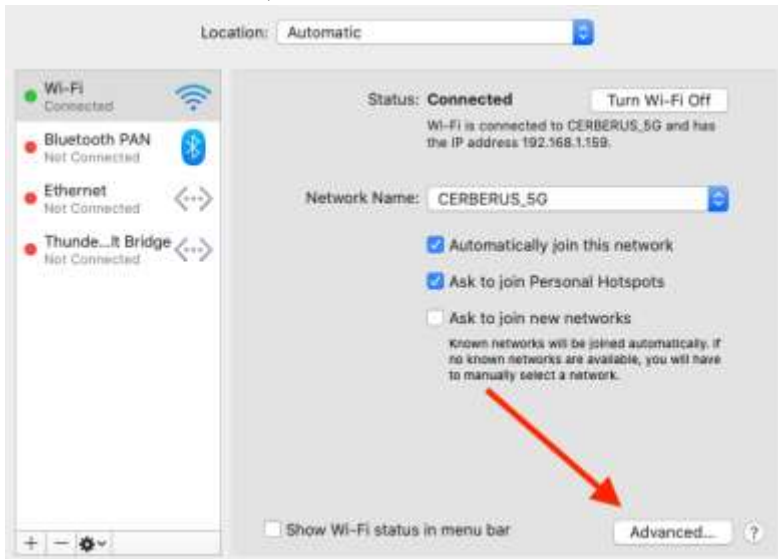
2. Click on "System Preferences"



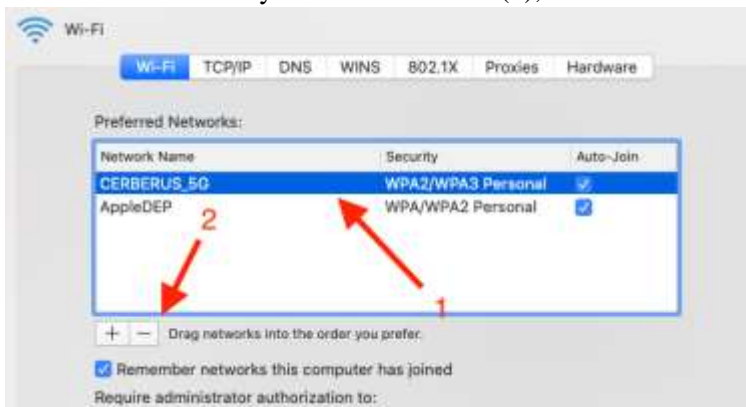
3. Click on "Network"
