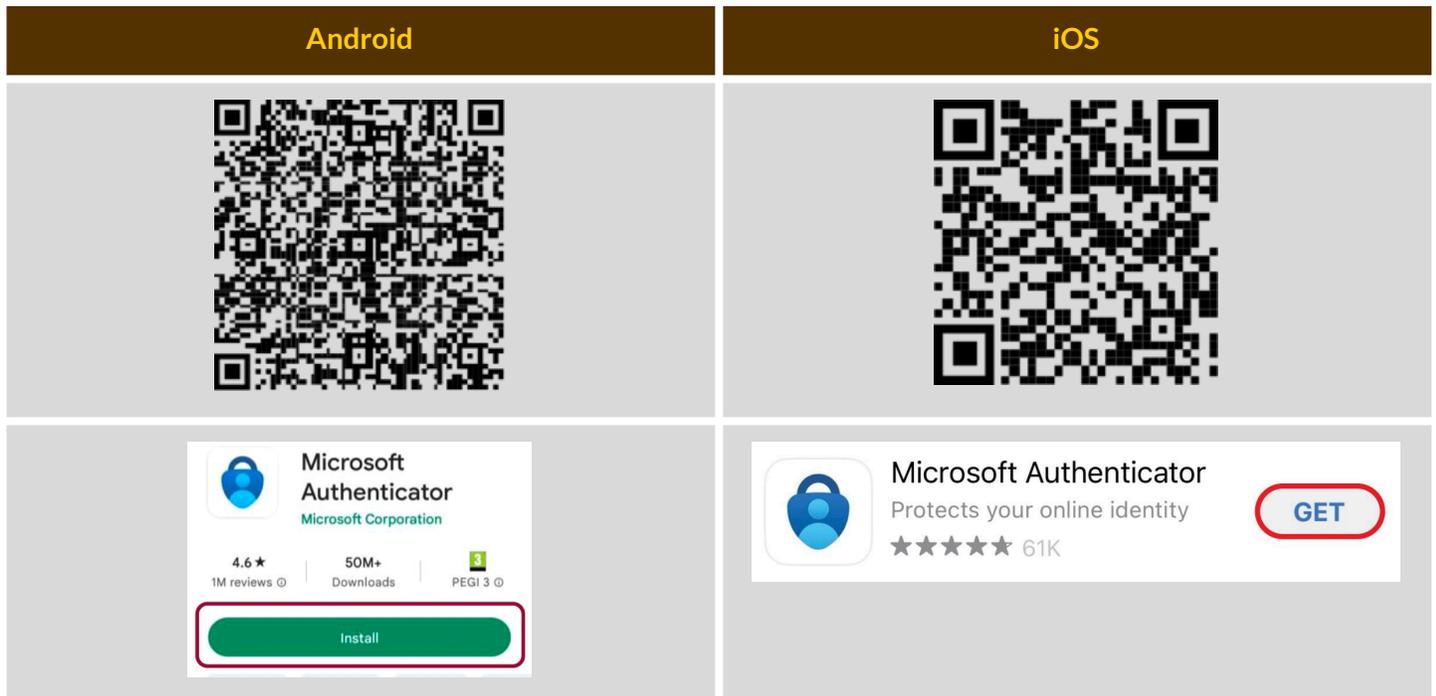


Microsoft MFA Setup Guide

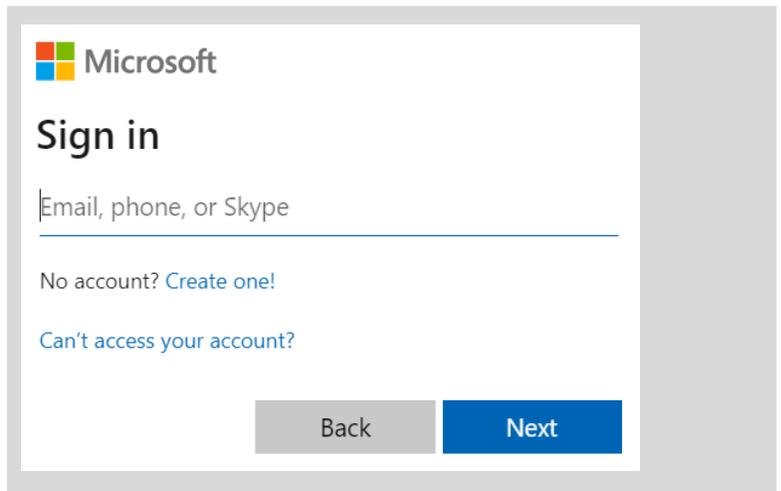
Step 1: Install the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device.

1. Download the Microsoft Authenticator app by scanning the appropriate QR code below. If you are unable to scan the QR code, search for “microsoft authenticator” in your mobile device’s app store.



Step 2: Set up MFA on your user account.

1. On a computer, open a web browser and navigate to portal.office.com.



2. Enter your USF email address and click "Next".

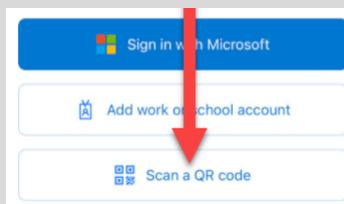
Use the Microsoft Authenticator app to scan the QR code. This will connect the Microsoft Authenticator app with your account.

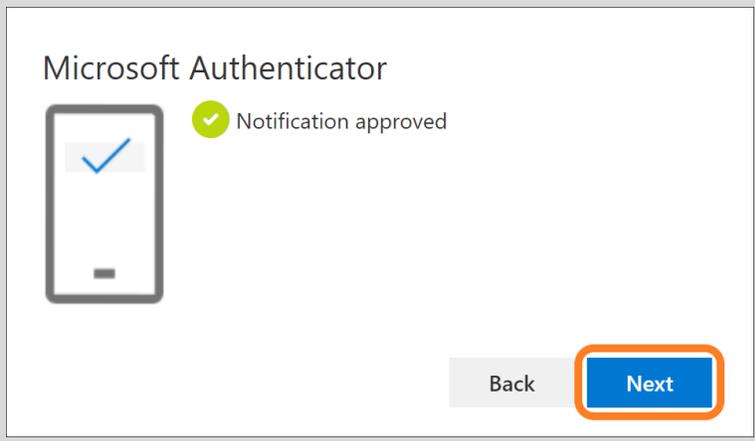

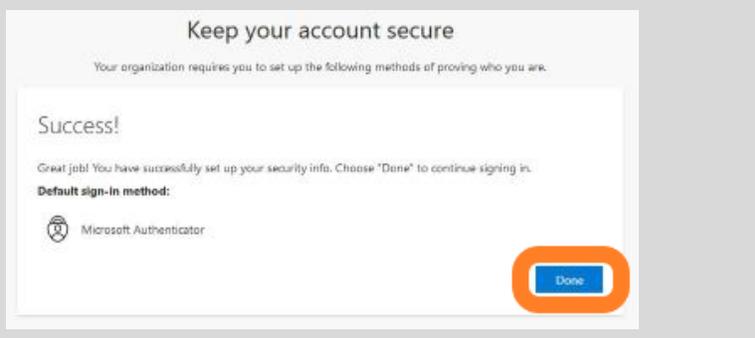
