



Introducing the Discussion Redesign in Canvas

Canvas's online asynchronous Discussions have undergone a change in look and feel. This introduction to the redesign will show you how to navigate and participate in the discussion redesign, which takes effect during the summer 2024 session.



First, you enter the discussion as you normally would. The first thing you will see is a discussion topic such as the hypothetical example shown below.



The top row of this view displays the following controls that are explained:




As you read the discussion topic and scroll down, you will see replies followed by secondary replies that you click on to read. By choosing the “Expand Threads” button, you see all replies at once.



The button is a toggle so that you can collapse the threads.



The View Split Screen command may be convenient for discussions with numerous replies. After you select it and hit reply to a discussion message, the window will divide into two frames. The left frame will display the message you are replying to. The right frame will display that message and ensuing replies beneath it, to which you can add your own reply (see image next page).



The button is a toggle. Clicking View Inline switches back to the full-width view in the browser.
